Pants must adhere to these guidelines. Cargo pants are not appropriate for school. School pants must be a dress, "Docker" style pant. If you have questions concerning these guidelines, please ask before you purchase.

KINDERGARTEN DRESS CODE

Boys are to wear the appropriately sized (neat-fitting) black or blue pants (uniform or Docker-style, not cargo pants) and school logo red or white polo shirt to school. Uniform options include a V-neck school logo sweater vest, school logo cardigan sweater, and the school logo sweatshirt. Socks must be worn with shoes. Boys are not to wear jewelry of any kind. Cartilage and body piercing of any kind are not permitted for boys. Conservative, traditional, neat haircuts are acceptable if hair does not hang below the top of the eyebrows and does not hang over or touch the ear or collar. Hair styles are not to be excessively full or faddish.

LOWER ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

Boys are to wear the appropriately sized (neat-fitting) black or blue pants (uniform or Docker-style, not cargo pants) and school logo red or white polo shirt to school. Uniform options include a V-neck school logo sweater vest, school logo cardigan sweater, and school logo sweatshirt. Crew length socks must be worn with shoes. Shirttails are to remain tucked in while at school and school functions. Boys are not to wear jewelry of any kind. Cartilage and body piercing of any kind are not permitted for boys. Conservative, traditional, neat haircuts are acceptable if hair does not hang below the top of the eyebrows and does not hang over or touch the ear or collar. Hair styles are not to be excessively full or faddish.

UPPER ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

Boys are to wear the appropriately sized (neat-fitting) black or blue pants (uniform or Docker-style, not cargo pants) and white oxford/school logo red or white polo shirt to school. Uniform options include a white dress shirt, a V-neck school logo sweater vest, a school logo cardigan sweater, a black tie and the school uniform tie. Shirttails are to remain tucked in while at school and school functions. Boys must wear a plain blue, black or brown belt to school. Crew length socks are to be worn with shoes. Boys are not to wear jewelry of any kind with the exception of a wrist watch. Cartilage and body piercing of any kind are not permitted for boys. Conservative, traditional, neat haircuts are acceptable if hair does not hang below the top of the eyebrows and does not hang over or touch the ear or collar. Hair styles are not to be excessively full or faddish.

HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Young men are to wear the appropriately sized (neat-fitting) black or khaki slacks (uniform or Docker-style slacks, not cargo pants) with the white oxford shirt/school logo black, red, or white polo shirt to school. Uniform options include a pullover V-neck school logo sweater, a school logo cardigan sweater, a black tie and the school uniform tie. Crew length or cuffed socks are to worn with shoes (socks must be visible above the shoe). Athletic footwear may only be worn during physical education class or when attending a home athletic event. Casual footwear, boots and footwear that resembles athletic footwear may not be worn to school. Young men in grades 7-12 are to wear dress shoes or shoes similar to the Rockport Bridgeport boat shoe or Dockers tassel slip-on shoe to school. Shoes must be black, brown, or cordovan in color. Plain brown, cordovan, or black belts are to be worn daily. Shirttails are to remain tucked in so that the belt is visible for a neat appearance. Dressy or formal occasions require men to wear dress shirts, dress slacks, dress shoes, coat and tie. Mock turtlenecks are not acceptable. Young men are not to wear jewelry with the exception of class rings and wrist watches. Cartilage and body piercing of any kind are not permitted. Young men in grades 7-12 are to be clean shaven with no facial hair. Side burns are to be no longer than the middle of the ear. Conservative, traditional, neat haircuts are acceptable if hair does not hang below the top of the eyebrows, and does not hang over or touch the ear or collar. Hair styles are not to be excessively full or faddish.
