

Reminders for 2016 - 2017

Dress Code

Young men are to wear ankle or crew length socks to school. Socks must be seen above top of shoes. No-show socks are not permitted. Young men may wear dress shoes or gym shoes.

Young Men Grades 7-12

Belts worn to school must be plain brown, cordovan, or black belts. Belts are mandatory for male students.

Young men are to be clean shaven with no facial hair. Sideburns are to be no longer than the middle of the ear. Conservative, traditional, neat haircuts are acceptable if hair does not hang below the top of the eyebrows and does not hang over or touch the ear or collar. Hair styles are not to be excessively full or faddish.

Young men may purchase “Docker” style pants that are not from Flynn & O’Hara. These pants must be navy blue, black, or khaki in color and may not be cargo pants. Pants may not be rolled or have elastic on the pant legs. Polo shirts from Flynn & O’Hara may be purchased in these colors: red, black, white, dark blue and grey.

Young Ladies Grades 7-12

Ladies are to wear dress shoes or gym shoes to school. Casual footwear (Dr. Scholl’s sandals, flip-flops, hiking boots, moccasins, slippers, etc.) may not be worn to school. Sandals must have the strap on the heel. Ladies in grades 7-12 must purchase polo shirts from Flynn & O’Hara in any color.

Book Fees

All book fees are due by July 31, 2016.

School Policy on Phones/Personal Electronic Devices

The administration requires that students obtain a pass/permission from a supervisor before using a hallway phone. All calls must be business in nature; no personal or frivolous calls.

We ask that parents and students help us in keeping the phones as free as possible for those who do need to make urgent calls.

Students may **not** use any personal electronic communication or message devices during the academic school day, 8:00 a.m. – 3:15 p.m. (cell phones, iPods, etc.). These items are not to be turned on during the academic school day. Phones may be carried in grades 7-12; however, all phones must be placed on the teacher’s desk at the beginning of each class. These items will be confiscated by FBS personnel and given to the FBS administrator if there is a violation. Confiscated items will be returned to the parents of the student. Students will receive discipline consequences for this offense. Kindergarten/elementary students are not permitted to bring any of the aforementioned items to school. This includes cell phones.

Internet Policy

The internet is a great tool; however, it can be a detriment to the spiritual growth of our students. Inappropriate material and inappropriate or harmful conversations should not be a part of Christian conduct anywhere including websites and blogs. Keep in mind that information on the internet is considered to be public domain and is never truly private.

All students must have a signed current internet use form on file in the school office in order to access the internet from FBS computers including library computers, the computer lab, and classroom computers. Access to the internet at FBS is designed for educational purposes. Students are not permitted to access personal websites or email accounts while using school computers.
