*Starting 2016-17 four credits will be required for General Diploma.

NOTES: U.S. history, U.S. government, and VA history are required for both the general and academic diplomas.

The academic diploma requires completion of math courses as listed in either academic track #1 or academic track #2. Courses must be taken in sequence. High school credit must be earned for each course.

The academic diploma will be awarded to students with a cumulative 3.0+ GPA and the required 27 credits.

Choir, band, and speech/drama electives require performances outside of school time. These performances will affect a student's grade. There is a special dress code assigned to these performances. See dress code for ODACS.

The SAT I or ACT College Board test is required for graduation. One of these tests must be taken by the student as a junior or senior **prior** to graduation. Official score reports must be sent to the school. Students must put the school code for FBS on the College Board registration form in order for FBS to receive official score reports. **The school code for FBS is 470-877.**
